Volunteer Opportunities

Meals on Wheels

Volunteers are required to deliver hot and frozen meals to the client's home. Meals are delivered Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in Belleville, and Monday, Wednesday and Friday in

Deseronto at 11:00 a.m.

Time Commitment: One hour per scheduled day.

Transportation

Volunteer drivers are required to provide long distance and local transportation for eligible clients to medical appointments. Drivers are reimbursed for mileage.

Time commitment: Variable depending on appointment, location and number of drives.



Telephone Reassurance

Volunteers are required to make scheduled telephone calls to house-bound or isolated clients. The purpose of the call is to provide friendship, reassurance and a safety check to clients in need.

Time Commitment: Varies with the ratio of clients to volunteers.

Activity Program

This program offers activities and social interaction in a group setting. Volunteers are required to provide transportation to clients, to assist with activities and refreshments.

Time Commitment: Thursday afternoons.

Congregate Dining

Hot and nutritious dinners are provided to clients in four different communities in our service area. Volunteers are required to provide transportation to clients, to assist with set-up and clean-up of dinner, and to assist with food preparations.

Time Commitment: Approximately one to three hours per dinner.

Administration and Fundraising

Volunteers are required to sit on the Board of Directors and help develop program policies and procedures.

Volunteers are also needed to assist with various fundraisers throughout the year.

This includes special events, presentations and the Christmas Wrap program at the Quinte Mall in December.

Time Commitment: Variable

Friendly Visiting

A volunteer visits a client on a regularly scheduled basis to provide friendship and support. The volunteer may read, write letters, chat or go for a walk with a client.

Time Commitment: One hour per week

Community Care Closet (Deseronto)

Volunteers are needed to work in the Community Care Closet throughout the year. The store is open Tuesday to Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Time Commitment: 3 hour shifts
